South Coast Families First Program Overview:

Family Support and Connections (FS & C): FS & C visits are designed to strengthen families and support effective parenting to families on TANF in Coos County, with children birth through 18 years of age in the home. This family designed program focuses on keeping families together and help you achieve your individual and family goals. Supporting Transitions Employment & Progress (STEP): Through workshops and individual visits, STEP works to provide parents on TANF in Coos and Curry Counties the tools they need to find and maintain employment, develop healthy relationships and engage in positive healthy living. Family Assistance & Support Team (FAST): FAST supports families in Coos and Curry Counties with crisis and follow-up services in the area of housing, food, health and economic stability. Services available via referral through a referring organization including DHS, Head Start and the Ark Program.

Overview of Key Duties and Responsibilities:

Provide home visiting and supportive services within South Coast Families FIRST Family Support & Connections (FS&C), according to program work plans, program goals, and contract rules and regulations. Facilitate Make Parenting a Pleasure workshops.

Position Qualifications:

- Credential, Certification, or AA/AS in social work, human services, family services, counseling, or related field with and or two years of experience preferred.
- BA/BS in social work, human services, family services, counseling, or related field preferred.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Strong organization and time management skills.
- Home visiting with an understanding of childhood development experience preferred.
- Work outside of the office at irregular including evenings and weekend hours at times will be required.
- Attendance at off-site staff training events will be required.
- Driving is required to conduct home visits and to attend off-site meetings/trainings
- Adhere to agency procedures as a mandated child abuse reporter
- Regular attendance is a requirement of the position
